Who We Are

Homer Flex High School is a standards/performance-based high school that is devoted to serve the needs of young people who have not been able to find success in a traditional school setting.

Standard/Performance-based learning at Flex is...

- Individualized/Student centered
- Project-based/Interdisciplinary
- Assessed by performance

Academic requirements differ from those of traditional high schools. Students are accountable for meeting standards in each of the seven areas:

- Mathematical Reasoning
- English/Language Arts
- Social Environments
- Science/Global Environments
- Technology Literacy
- Career and Employability Skills
- Personal/Social/Service Learning (Character Education)

Graduation levels in each of these standards are required for a KPBSD diploma. Graduation is based on proficient performance at each level, not years attended. Proficient levels convert to credits at graduation or for transfer students.

What Happens at Flex

One of our school's main objectives is to develop in each student the habits that will help him/her succeed in the workplace. The school environment resembles that of the working world. Students are encouraged to be self-reliant, self-motivated, and responsible. Self-discipline is very important at Flex.

Flex has high expectations that students respect themselves, others, and their environment.

The Homer Flex Day

Student classes begin at 8:30 AM. If a student is late or absent, s/he must call or text the school secretary before 8:30 AM (or before 1:00 PM if s/he is not coming back to school after lunch) on the day of the absence. Any tardy over a half hour will be counted as a half-day absence. Failure to inform the school secretary or principal before leaving the building while school is in session will result in disciplinary action.

Consequences of accumulated tardies and absences:

Four (4) unexcused absences or tardies in a quarter: referral to Intervention Team (I-Team) for plan of improvement.

Eight (8) accumulated absences or tardies in a quarter: referral to I-Team for plan of improvement.

Flex High School is a drug-free school. We adhere to the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District's policies on tobacco and drug/alcohol possession and/or use on school premises.

Admission

Prospective students are asked to spend a day at Flex and then follow up with an interview with a team of students and faculty. Once accepted, students will spend several days completing entry-level placement tests in reading, writing, and math.
